### Community Roadwatch - HVC 274

Local residents work in partnership with the Police Safer Transport Team (STT) & TFL for their borough, and use speed detection equipment to identify speeding vehicles.

#### School Governor - HVC - 277

Havering schools need governors. Use your skills and expertise to help children's education.

### Havering Street Watch Member HVC - 264

A great opportunity for anyone who wants to help the community. Havering Street Watch needs your help. Are you over the age of 16 and interested in becoming a Street Watch Member.

### Welcome/Wayfinder - HVC - 162

The aim of this role is front of house based and involves a great deal of interaction with patients and the general public.

### Housebound Hero - HVC-151

Havering Library Service needs volunteers to deliver books and items to Havering residents in their own homes.

Our Housebound service enables people who can't visit a library in person to still access our service.

### Volunteer Gardener

Ultimately the aim is to set up a Friends of the blind garden group, for fellow like minded gardeners to get their teeth in to a project and turn it back into the beautiful oasis it once was.
