WELCOME 2020!

As we head into the year ahead it's always good to look back and reflect on the past year.

2019 has been no different for HVC compared to others, it's been busy, exciting and there has been highs and lows. What has remained the same is the amount of interest in volunteering and our own wonderful team of volunteers that help keep our services going strong.

2019 saw just over 1000 volunteers engage with our services and over 1600 referrals to voluntary services. Just over 50 people registered to undertake a Level 2 vocational qualification; everyone passed their course and then went on to secure volunteering, employment or higher education.

HVC also received a Team London nomination for our training provision and our team from Network Rail, won an award for their Gift of Time under the Employee Supported Volunteering category, for supporting HVC restore and maintain the Secret Garden for the Blind.

What does 2020 hold for HVC?

Fundraising is high on our agenda this year. HVC will be holding lots of events to help generate some much needed funds to support our activities and are also looking for people who would like to host events on our behalf. If you fancy a challenge and could help us by organising a fundraising event or sponsored walk, jog or run then we would love to hear from you!

Ultimately for HVC, 2020 will be all about getting more of the community involved in volunteering, keep your eyes peeled for our events and fayres and if you overhear anyone thinking about volunteering, send them our way!


