Description

Do you love wildlife ? Do you have a few spare hours to help us with our Wildlife Survey ?

Wildlife Survey Volunteers get involved in wildlife surveys, building up our knowledge of water voles and other animals on site and contributing to national monitoring. You will team up with other volunteers to check transects and look for water vole signs to determine water vole presence and how they are using the site.

You could also get involved in recording other wildlife such as birds, butterflies, wildflowers, harvest mice or ancient trees. There is some flexibility, but ideally volunteers could commit to surveying at least once per month. Surveying should take no more than a few hours

Previous experience is not necessary but you will have an interest in UK wildlife, a good level of physical fitness and a willingness to learn
