We cannot believe we are 3 months into the New Year already and it's already been a busy one!

HVC are currently operating on a skeleton staff base supported by wonderful internal volunteers. Despite this from the 1st January – 28th February 2025 we have had 298 individuals register their interest in volunteering, with 45 new volunteering opportunities becoming available.

HVC said farewell in February to our young Volunteer who joined HVC 13 weeks ago as part of her Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award. She joined us and undertook various administrative tasks that will help work towards skill building. Everyone at HVC wishes her the very best as she continues her learning, we know that she will flourish and continue to succeed.

Heading into March, HVC will be hosting their Annual General Meeting. This primarily is to look back and reflect on the past 12 months of achievement's but this year we will be heavily looking forward to what the future holds.

This is in further jeopardy as the rent on the building we hire from the Local Authority is also proposed to increase over 200%. Repair and Refurbishment Volunteer – Do you enjoy DIY and building/repairing things? Can you spare some time to join our welcoming team as a Repair and Refurbishment Volunteer? As a charity we are new to the area, we sell all sorts of new, repaired and refurbished goods for home refurbishment. This is a rewarding opportunity for someone with good DIY/Building skills to help breathe new life into pre-used donated items



Chair of Trustees – We are looking for a Chair of the Trustee Board for an initial appointment of up to three years, where after re-election is possible. The role of the Chair is to provide leadership to the organisation and the board by ensuring that everyone remains focused on the delivery of the organisation's charitable purposes in order to provide greater public benefit.



Warm Space Volunteer – As a Warm Space Volunteer with Tapestry, you will help create a welcoming and safe environment for individuals seeking warmth, support, and community. You will be to support with hospitality, engage with visitors and signpost them to additional services if needed. Sessions run on Tuesday's and Thursday's between 10.30am – 3pm.



Telephone Support Volunteer – Do you want to use your interpersonal skills over the telephone to provide vital support and services information to people affected by dementia? As a Telephone Support Volunteer you will help people living with dementia, affected by dementia or people that are worried about their memory connect to support and services that are available to them. You will provide a service that is tailored to a person's needs, interests, abilities, history and personality. You will be a key point of contact for people using our services, ensuring that we keep in touch with people at a time when they need our support. Please note that this role will be undertaken every Tuesday, working from St. Georges Hub in Hornchurch.



Live Streaming Volunteer – To ensure that our services reach the whole community – we live stream our Sunday 10am service, every week as a minimum (other services are occasionally live streamed). This is a great opportunity to ensure that our community sees the service and feel connected to the church despite not being in the vicinity. Your role will be to work in a team of two (the person varies as we work on a rota) to manage part of the system.



Practical Park Volunteer – Would you like to join our practical volunteer group and learn new skills, whilst helping the environment & wildlife? Join our Rangers on Tuesdays or Thursdays for the morning. You'll get to have a go at many tasks, such as coppicing, creating habitats and building fences. Come and help our Rangers with practical work that makes our country park a great place for people and wildlife. Volunteering at Belhus Woods is hands-on - a great way to meet people, learn about conservation, get a bit of exercise and make a difference.
